CORE Skills Courses (non assessed) – 2020 For General Practitioners and Practice Nurses

Waikato Postgraduate Medicine together with the Waikato Skills and Simulation Centre continue to run high quality resuscitation courses for GPs and Practice Nurses. These courses are endorsed and meet the requirements of the Royal NZ College of General Practitioners (RNZCGP). They are delivered by qualified and experienced NZRC instructors who are practicing medical, paramedical and nursing staff. For GPs requiring CME accreditation for AVE and MOPs these courses are endorsed for 8 CME credits. A Certificate of Participation is issued. **These courses are non-assessed.**

These courses, specifically for health professionals, cover a variety of clinical skills (as listed in the MOPS requirements manual) and also concepts around leadership, communication and teamwork. These non-assessed refresher sessions are held in the evening at the Waikato Skills and Simulation Centre, located on the ground floor of the Waikato Clinical Campus at Waikato Hospital. **Pre-registration is required and payment must accompany registration to secure your place. Course fees are \$258.75 - (\$225 plus GST \$33.75) and can be paid by cheque made out to “Waikato Postgraduate Medicine Inc” or by Internet banking.** (Account details for internet banking will be on the invoice for the course fees). All confirmation details, programme and invoice will be emailed to you very shortly after registration.

Pre-reading requirements

Please ensure you have read and understood the textbook “Resuscitation - a guide for advanced rescuers”. This manual contains the theory and knowledge directly applicable to the course and is available from the New Zealand Resuscitation Council (can be ordered/purchased via their website). Please request your Practice Manager to purchase a copy if this is not already available within your place of work. This manual can also be accessed through the Medical Library at Waikato Hospital for those GPs and Practice Nurses who have pre-booked on one of the courses listed below.

These evening courses commence promptly at 5:00pm and finish at approx. 10.00pm.

It is vital that you are in attendance for the full course components. A late arrival may result in you being required to re-book for another course date. A light snack is provided at the start, as well as a light dinner break during the evening. **It is important that you register promptly as course numbers are limited to ten participants.** Courses may be cancelled if sufficient registrations are not received by the due date.
