Is it fun and informative? Is it safe?

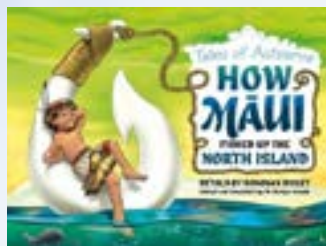
## We want to see what you have to offer!!
